



## **CARNATIX - Carnatic Music Certification Examinations** **GRADING POLICY**

**The grading rules and policy will be as follows.**

- a. 90+ in theory and 90+ in practical will be AA.**
- b. 80+ in theory and 80+ in practical will be BB.**
- c. 70+ in theory and 70+ in practical will be CC.**
- d. Students with 90+ in theory and 80+ in practical will be given AB and so on. Your aggregate score adding theory and practical score will be assigned a final letter grade.**
- e. Students below 70 but above 50 will get P in the Examination. But in Level III, minimum score required would be 70 in each segment to pass.**
- f. To graduate to next level the minimum score required will be 50 in each segment. However this is allowed only for Level I and Level II. For Level III and Level IV the minimum score required in each segment is 70 and for Level V and VI, the minimum score required in each segment is 80 to pass to next level. Level VII Qualification has certain norms set. The norms are**
  - i. 80+ in theory and 80+ in practical examination.**
  - ii. 5+ mini concerts after completing level V.**
  - iii. Detailed reports on atleast 10 professional concerts attended recently with songs, composers, ragas handled and your analysis of the concert.**
  - iv. 3 letters of recommendation from teachers, musicians in the field of carnatic music.**
  - v. Detailed application form with essay on your music goals.**

**Individual scores will be added and rank will be based on the total (theory and practical) score obtained by the student.**
